TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

This morning Lloyd Twite telephoned inquiring about the potential full effect of the city council's recent street striping of Linda Vista Boulevard to remove bicycle lanes. Lloyd Twite is inquiring as to whether a similar city policy would likely now apply to lower Miller Creek streets that are being developed as part of a subdivision on Shaver and Christian streets. Reportedly these are streets with hills in them and Lloyd would like to know if a similar policy is likely to be applied to these streets. If so, it may require amendment of a subdivision condition.

Jim,

Lloyd Twite asked that I forward to you the comments we received from staff regarding striping on Shaver Drive and Christian Drive. Our hope is to find a way to stripe these two streets in a manner that is desired by the neighborhood and will not cause the neighborhood to become upset that they are not being heard. We propose to stripe both of these two new streets in the same manner as was just decided by the neighborhood (and approved by City Council and implemented) for Linda Vista Boulevard. This would consist of Sharrows, centerlines and fog lines. I have attached below in the email chain the requests we sent to staff and the recent reply we received from staff for the recommended process to accomplish the striping goal.

We are hopeful that the Council can find a way to accomplish this goal without needing to revise the subdivision regulations and go to the lengths suggested by staff. It is not a matter of cost, as the developer is willing to donate any savings to the parks in the area. For information, the plat for the Linda Vista Fifteenth Supplement was recorded in the County and has since been annexed into the City. If there is anything else we can provide to help, please let us know.

Please let us know if the Council is able to assist with this concern.

Gilbert,

We were able to reach a consensus but I went home sick after the meeting and haven't been able to type up my notes in an email and send to you. I'm still at home sick and my notes are in the office. I'll follow up with any additional specifics tomorrow when I plan on being back in the office. In the meantime, I will say that we discussed the following:

- The subdivision conditions of Linda Vista 15th & 16th need to be changed through the County Commissioners as condition #11 of Linda Vista 15 & 16 require bike lanes on Shaver.
- You'll need to go to City Council (**likely start with the Ward Reps**) and request a change to the subdivision regulations that show bike lanes on collector streets (**the Table .2 A located within section 3-020**) .
- You'll need to request a phasing plan amendment for Linda Vista Estates and Teton Addition to modify the information shown and/or the condition for each subdivision. I'm to understand that the City is allowed by law to only modify conditions if there has been a change in standards. So when the subdivision regulations change (as mentioned in the second bullet above) we can then process the modifications.

- The above items need to be completed in concert of one another. The reason being is that if the Commissioners change the condition language and the City doesn't modify the City subdivision regulations then were back to the same scenario we're currently in – not having two different striping conventions on the same road (in the case of Shaver Drive).

Let me know how you want to proceed.

I thought I should follow up on the email I sent last week regarding the striping for streets in the Linda Vista area. The feedback we are receiving is that the neighborhood would like to have Shaver Drive and Christian Drive striped similarly to what was just decided and implemented on Linda Vista Boulevard. The desired striping is sharrows, a center divide line and fog lines. We would like to know what the process would be in order of us to be able to use this same pattern for the striping on these two new streets. It is not a matter of cost, as the developer is willing to donate any estimated difference in cost to park improvements for the area. Please let us know what the process would be to consider using this striping. We are very willing to take this back before the Council, if that could help.

Mike,

After our consideration of the Council decision in committee to stripe Linda Vista Boulevard with sharrows, a center divide line and fog lines, we are proposing that the two new residential collectors in the neighborhood be striped in the same manner to satisfy the neighborhood desires. Shaver Drive and Christian Drive will both be steeper and have less traffic than Linda Vista Boulevard. In order to follow this striping plan desired by the neighborhood, a concern has been raised by Kevin Slovarp and Ben Weiss that we may need the City Council to determine that this striping plan meets the conditions of plat approval.

The conditions of approval of Teton Addition (Christian Drive) include condition #10 that addresses the bicycle striping. It reads,

*10. Plans for **striped bike lanes** on Lower Miller Creek Road and **Christian Drive** shall be reviewed and approved by City Engineering prior to final plat approval of the following phases: Phase West –Miller, Phase West - Woodchuck, Phase West – Kootenai, Phase West – Trapper, Phase East –Divide, and Phase East - Skalkaho.*

The upper portion of Shaver Drive was approved and recorded by the County and then annexed into the City. Because of this, there are no City subdivision conditions for the striping for the upper section of Shaver Drive. The lower portion of Shaver Drive is included in the approval by the City for

Linda Vista Estates. While this lower portion of Shaver Drive hasn't been constructed yet, the striping should be consistent throughout the neighborhood and from top to bottom on Shaver Drive and we would like to determine the proper striping for all of Shaver Drive. The Linda Vista Estates subdivision condition of approval (#6) that would apply to the lower portion of Shaver Drive reads as follows:

6. Plans for installing curb/gutter, complete drainage facilities, sidewalk, and pavement on subdivision roadways to dimensions and in locations proposed on Supplemental Data Sheets 1 — 5 and 10, dated October 23, 2008, the short court detail plan contained in the subdivision application, and Road Plans Sheet 1 — 8 included in the application packet, shall be reviewed and approved by the City Engineer prior to final plat approval of each phase.

My question is what is the proper procedure to be able to stripe these two streets in harmony with the voice of the residents. Do we need to bring this item before the Council to consider if the striping proposal meets the condition of approval or can it be handled at a staff level?

CITY COUNCIL MEMBERS:

Subsection 20.90.020(C) Missoula Municipal Code pertaining to the design review board entitled "TERMS" states:

C. TERMS. Members of the Design Review Board serve terms to be set by the City Council, ranging from one to three years at the City Council's discretion. In setting terms, the City Council must attempt to stagger the expiration of board members to help ensure continuity."

A referral should be made to land use and planning committee to establish a method or process pursuant to which the city council staggers the terms of current design review board members and then assigns the staggering to the current design review board members. There does not appear to be any need for an amendment to city ordinances, the city council is already directed to stagger the terms pursuant to the current ordinance.
