- I understand that a single water service line may serve a main building and an accessory building such as an additional dwelling unit, garage, workshop, etc. as defined in ARM 17-38-101. The existing main building must be metered and the new accessory building must be connected after the water meter. The existing water meter will be allowed to remain inside the main building. This will not require a separate account.
- I understand that an additional accessory building such as a permanent rental unit may be tapped off of the existing service line if the existing building is metered and an additional curb box and meter pit is installed for the new dwelling. This will require a separate address and a separate account.
- I understand that if this lot is subdivided each main building will need a separate water service line.
- Metering: All new accounts must be metered. If an existing flat rate account is adding an accessory building, the flat rate building must install a meter. Each building must also have a separate outside shut off or curb box.

According to the rules above:

- This project requires separate billing accounts; two meters.
- This project requires one billing account; one meter.
