



Demolition Permit Instructions

Property owner(s) (“Owner”) intending to demolish property improvements, including water service lines are required to obtain a City of Missoula Demolition Permit.

Before Missoula Water signs the City of Missoula Demolition Permit, Owner must follow the procedures outlined in Section 1 or Section 2 below:

SECTION 1

Permanent Discontinuance of Water Service

If Owner desires to permanently discontinue its water service, Owner must abandon the water service line by excavation or hydrovac in accordance with City of Missoula Standard Drawing 310 by:

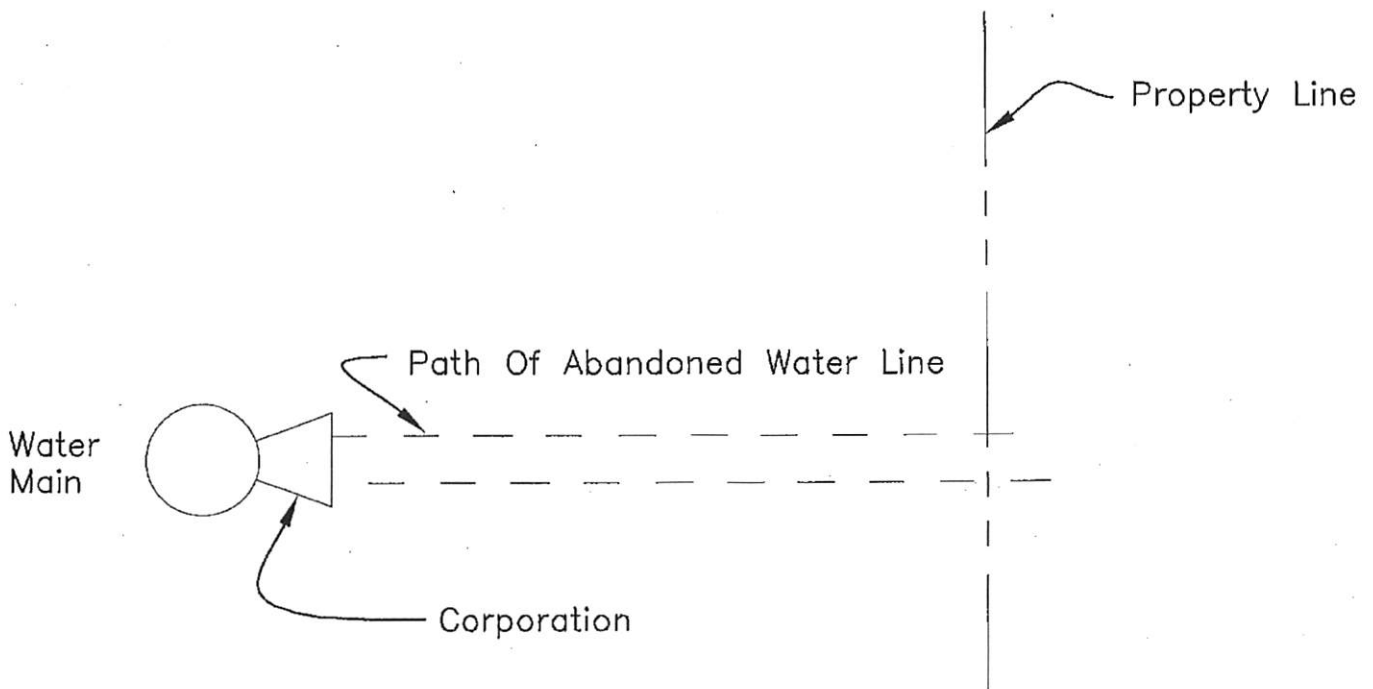
- exposing the corporation stop valve at the water main; and
- close the valve, cut out and permanently remove a section of the water service line immediately downstream of the valve; and
- notify Missoula Water of the abandonment while the corporation stop valve and removed section of service line is still exposed so that Missoula Water can visually inspect the abandonment. ***Call our dispatch office for an appointment to witness the abandonment at 552-6752.***
- when the line has been abandoned and witnessed by a Missoula Water field service/distribution technician, the demo permit can be signed in the field or at the office at 1345 W Broadway.

SECTION 2

Water Service Line Reuse

- Poly service lines newer than the year 2000 may be reused without leak testing the line.
- If a poly line is older than the year 2000, please contact Missoula Water directly at 552-6752 for regulations regarding older poly service lines.
