WHEREAS, Ron MacDonald served over twenty years as a board member of the City of Missoula Redevelopment Agency and was both steadfast and energetic in his advocacy and support for the development of riverfront parks and trails; and

WHEREAS, Ron MacDonald's vision for a riverfront trail system, which engages citizens with their natural environment and enhances the downtown area and economy, has clearly helped to make Missoula one of the most desirable places in the nation to live, work and play; and

WHEREAS, The City of Missoula declared that Ron's River Trail shall be the trail which parallels the Clark Fork River on the north side of the river, starting in Caras Park and extending east and west to the incorporated Missoula City limits; and
