Hello Michael,

I live in Grant creek too and like many Missoula residents I understand your frustration. Last fall when leaf collection was scheduled to take place there were still many leaves on the trees, thus the schedule was delayed. Then we got an earlier than anticipated snow event and therefore the city was not able to collect leaves anywhere. It has been a city wide challenge this year but the Public Works department is currently working on addressing it.

From the public works department website:

- **We need to have several warm days in a row so that snow and ice can melt off of the leaves, allowing us to see them and collect them without damaging our equipment.**
- **We will follow the order shown in the schedule (shown on the right side of this web page) once we are able to begin collection.**
- **Please note that depending on weather conditions, we could have several starts and stops before we've been able to complete our collection in all neighborhoods.**

I will send you an email as soon as I get notice of an updated schedule. I am linking the page with leaf collection information as well.
