I'm passing along some information from our wonderful partners at Partnership Health Center who will be providing the supportive services at the new Blue Heron Place permanent supportive housing homes, which are part of Trinity on the Mullan campus. Please see the below information about a donation collection opportunity and feel free to share widely with your networks.

Soon 30 homes will be open at Blue Heron Place, a permanent supportive housing program here in Missoula. This represents an important step forward in efforts to meet the demand for homes in our community. Permanent supportive housing is an evidence-based model designed to provide residents with helpful resources to stay housed and improve their overall well-being. Residents often have severe health challenges and have experienced homelessness for long periods of time.

The beautiful homes at Blue Heron Place are furnished but lack basic household items like sheets, towels, and hygiene products. [Partnership Health Center invites you to donate these items through an Amazon registry.](#) Donors can select, purchase, and send requested items within a few clicks.
