Each year, our nation commemorates the signing of the U.S. Constitution, thanks to a congressional resolution signed in 1956 by President Dwight D. Eisenhower designating September 17-23 as Constitution Week. The original request for such a week came from the Daughters of the American Revolution (DAR), a nonprofit organization of women whose ancestors fought in the American Revolution.

Locally, the Bitter Root Chapter of DAR in Missoula has promoted educational activities to encourage students to learn more about their country's Constitution. We contacted schools throughout a two-county area and offered posters, student kits, copies of library books, teaching materials, lesson plans and even a visit from "Martha Washington" in person.
